

LISTEN & SPEAK UP

A summer program for children with hearing loss focusing on listening and speaking



IOWA

Listen and Speak Up combines group and individual therapy using an individualized approach to facilitate communication. Fun, age-appropriate activities to enhance communication skills are provided by graduate clinicians under the supervision of licensed speech-language pathologists and audiologists. Parents are invited to weekly sessions to learn strategies for use at home.

Children with hearing loss who are 3 – 6 years of age are invited to apply for the Listen and Speak Up program, scheduled for Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 9 a.m. – noon, June 7 - July 21, 2022. Sessions are held at the Wendell Johnson Speech and Hearing Clinic on the University of Iowa campus in Iowa City.

Some or all costs may be covered depending on individual insurance plans. We submit claims to a large number of carriers. A sliding fee scale is available for families who qualify.

Our clinic follows all recommended Covid safety guidelines. Children are encouraged to wear facemasks, and adults must wear facemasks at all times in the building. Additional information regarding current safety recommendations will be shared with families.
