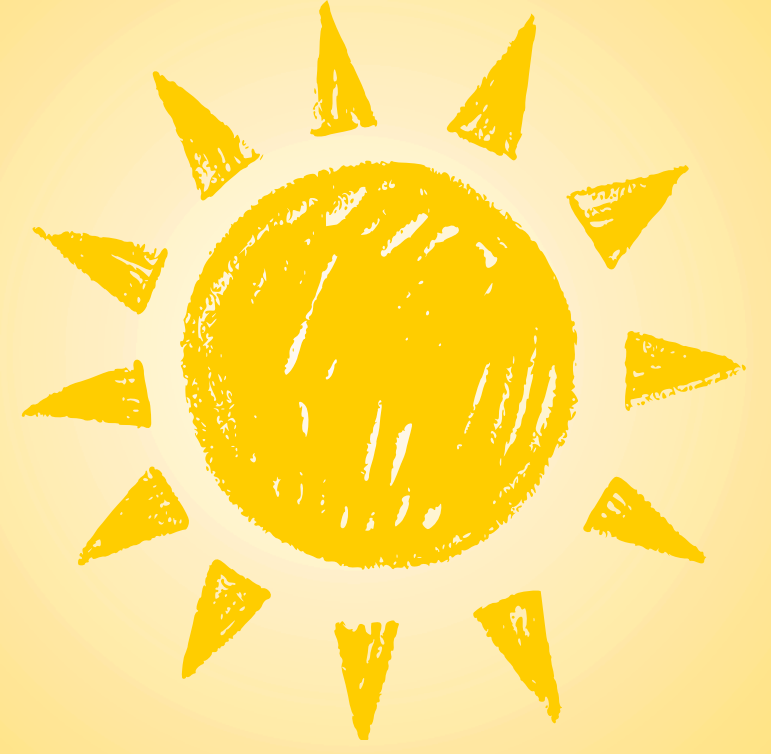


# UI SHINE

Are Deaf/Hard of Hearing in an Inclusive, Nurturing Environment

**Participants:** Youth ages 7–17 who stutter or are Deaf/hard of hearing. Enrollment may be limited to ensure active group participation and enriching experiences.

**Clinicians:** Graduate student clinicians will lead the sessions, supervised by licensed speech-language pathologists who specialize in stuttering and aural (re)habilitation.



## Daily individual therapy and group experiences designed to help participants:

- Explore self-advocacy and communication skills
- Build awareness of their own unique way of communicating
- Connect with others who have similar challenges
- Develop confidence in communication

Through generous donations, our 2026 program is being offered at **no cost** for all participants. To continue offering this program at no cost in the future summers, donations for this summer program are welcome. Cost per child for:

- Therapy: \$320
- Meals: \$80
- Materials and programming: \$30

Overnight option available if enough participants would like to stay overnight. Overnight option adds approximately \$350 for 3 nights (room + board). If the overnight cost is a barrier, please contact us.
