WHO

Campers: Youth ages 7–17 who stutter or are Deaf/hard of hearing.
Enrollment may be limited.

Clinicians: Graduate student clinicians will lead the sessions supervised by licensed clinicians

WHAT

Daily individual and group therapy experiences designed to help campers:

- **Explore** self-advocacy and communication skills
- **Build** awareness of their own unique way of communicating
- **Connect** with others who have similar challenges
- **Develop** confidence communicating and explaining their diagnosis in a variety of situations

OVERNIGHT

Overnight option available if sufficient interest
Campers stay in the University of Iowa dorms

COST

Program cost: \$320 for the 4-day program.

Will be billed to insurance if possible
